Northeast Chapter Scholarship Request Guidelines

The mission of the Florida Nursery, Growers & Landscape Association is to promote and protect the interests of Florida's nursery and landscape industry. FNGLA is Florida's oldest and largest association targeting the needs of the Florida's environmental horticulture industry, which has an estimated \$15.2 billion in industry-wide sales annually.

The primary goal of the FNGLA Northeast Chapter Scholarship Fund is to support the continuing education of graduating high school seniors who will be joining a college program of study in horticulture, or related agricultural field, including agricultural education, horticultural sciences, or environmental sciences. Interested parties can applicator for two separate scholarships:

1) The FNGLA Northeast Chapter Scholarship is considered twice per year on January 15th, and June 15th of each year

2) **The Billy Barwald Memorial Scholarship**, in honor of Billy Barwald, owner of the Flying Dragon Citrus Nursery in Jacksonville, FL is awarded to one recipient per year for their outstanding achievements in and outside the school system. This scholarship is considered only once per year and applications for the Billy Barwald Scholarship are due on January 15th of each year.

The follow criteria are required for all applications:

- Applicant must be a current resident in the state of Florida in the following counties: St. Johns, Duval, Clay, Nassau, or Baker. Intended college of choice must be in the state of Florida, but not limited to the previously stated counties.
- Applicant must be an incoming college freshman, sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student planning to attend a community college, college, university or other post graduate program.
- Applicant must have a current GPA of 3.0 and work to maintain that
- Applicant must be enrolled full-time in a college horticulture program or agriculture related field with the intent to graduate in that field. Award recipients are eligible to reapply for scholarship annually.

Applicators for the NEFNGLA Scholarship should submit the following to be considered:

- □ (1) NEFNGLA Scholarship Application
- (1) 500-word essay that includes your request for financial assistance from the Northeast Chapter of FNGLA, your experiences in the horticulture or agriculture industry thus far, your goals for pursuing an education in the field of horticulture and agriculture and the importance of that education to you and our local community in Florida.
- □ (2) Letters of Recommendations, from two different school teachers/professors/educators
- (1) Letter of Recommendations, from any previous work supervisor(s) (past 5 years) (*if applicable*)
- (1) Copy of unofficial school/college transcripts (can be forward from institution, but must be received by Scholarship deadline).
